# ISE Student Rank Requirements



## **Medallion: Gold Triangle, Ebony Circle - (Serve the Art) KATALUNGAN GURO (probationary instructor rank)**

In order to be acknowledged for their progress in the Inayan School of Eskrima and achieve the Level Six rank, Students will need to be knowledgeable and proficient in the following areas and perform all duties as assigned. A STUDENT MUST ALSO MAINTAIN KNOWLEDGE AND PROFICIENCY OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE LOWER LEVELS.

- Beginning with the Fifth level, Students will at times assist Guros in running ISE classes as directed by Tagaturo Klement.
- Be proficient in advanced Serrada flow-sparring and Lock and Block reflex drills.
- Be proficient in all known counters - all styles (must be able to block full powered, full speed strikes under duress).
- Demonstrate Mastery in all known basic counters - all styles (must be able to break down and teach each counter as "Text Book Basics" to beginner Students with Tagaturo's approval).
- Be proficient in advanced Lock and Block reflex drills.
- Be proficient in advanced Serrada, Kadena and Largo counters.
- Be proficient in advanced Inayan drills and exercises.
- Be able to "Flow" in all core styles and from style to style.
- Be proficient with a flexible or semi-flexible weapon.
- Be proficient with a long range weapon such as the staff, spear, whip, whip stick, etc.
- Show proficiency and working knowledge of a healing art.
- A U.S. passport must be attained.
- Do volunteer work at a Mission or Red Cross or Ride along with a Patrol Officer or EMT.
- Show proficiency in one of the hand-thrown and one of the mechanically assisted projectile weapons you chose during your 5th Level Rank/Testing.
- Turn in a Paper stating why you have decided to (or decided not to) exercise your Carry Permit.
- Turn in a Paper on what Loyalty means to you as it relates to Inayan Eskrima and your Teacher.
- Creation: Demonstrate to Tagaturo and in class a new drill for each of the core styles (Serrada, KDM and Largo Mano).
- Required duty: Mandatory minimum - one class per week, open and close the School and prepare the training area.
- Required duty: Mandatory minimum - one private lesson per week, donate a one hour one on one lesson to a 3rd Level or lower.
